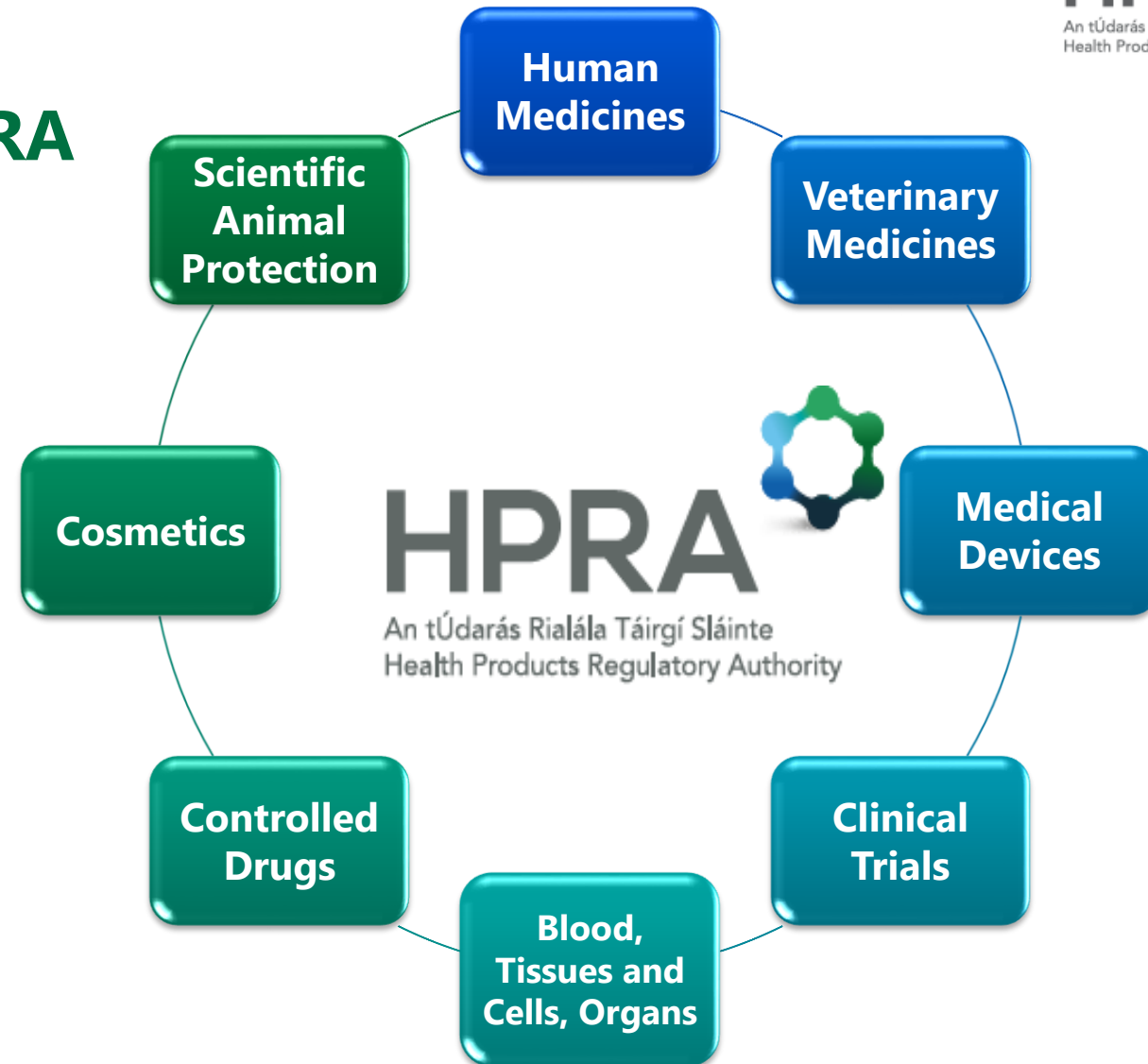

To protect and enhance public and animal health by regulating medicines, medical devices and other health products





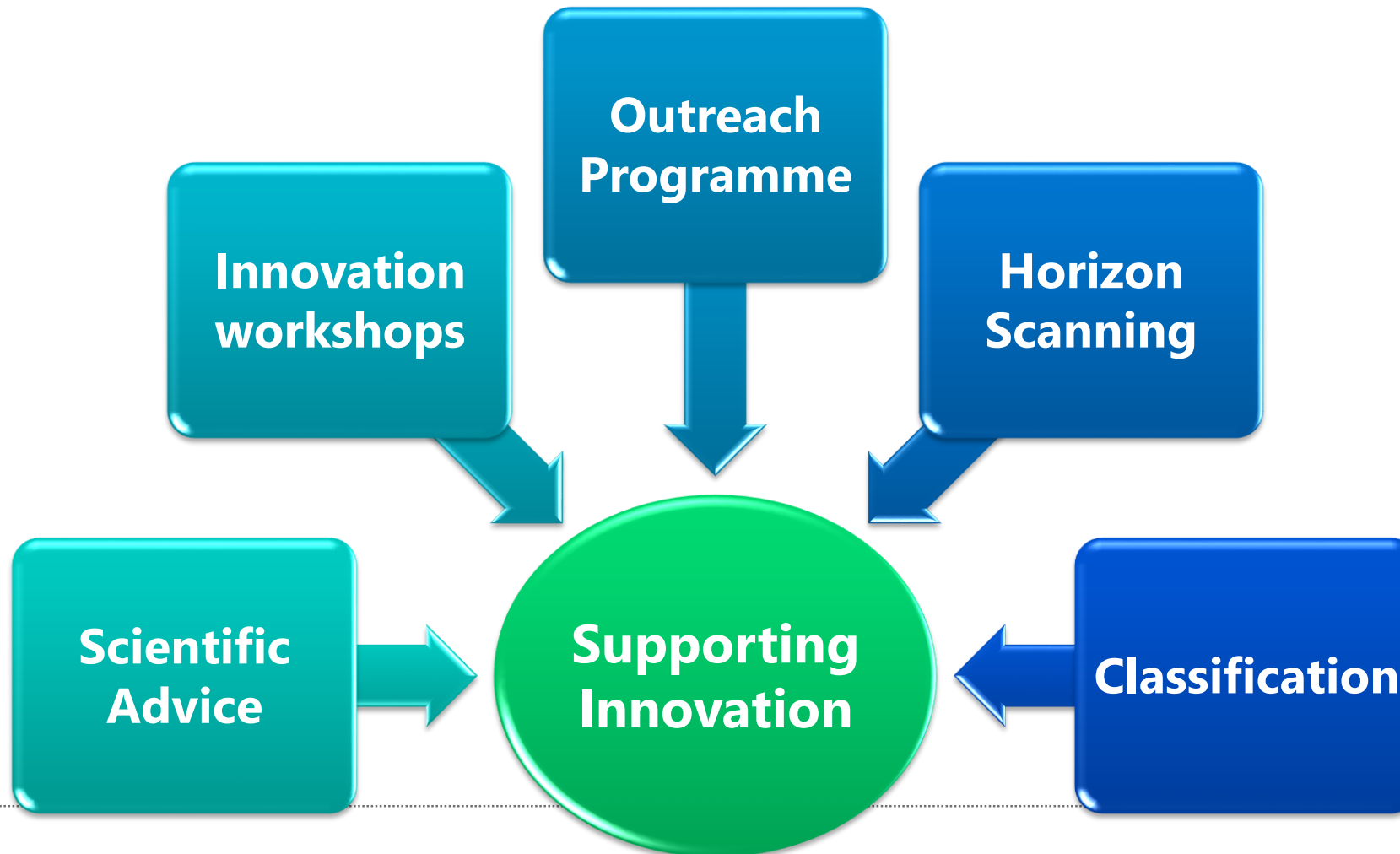
HPRA Innovation Office

- Initial point of contact for innovators to submit queries
- Queries can be submitted at any stage of development free of charge via a dedicated online form or email address
- Queries will be treated as confidential and reviewed by relevant HPRA experts
- Standard timeline for response is 20 working days
- HPRA is also part of the EU Innovation Network
