It is expected that the transposition deadline of 05 April 2024 will be met.
2. <a href="#">Directive (EU) 2022/2041</a> of 19 October 2022 on adequate minimum wages in the European Union.	15/11/24  <i><u>Unit:</u> Labour Market and Skills Unit.</i>	Assessment has begun on transposition requirements.  It is expected that the transposition deadline of 15 November 2024 will be met.

<p><b>4. <a href="#">Directive (EU) 2023/7020</a></b> amending Directive 2013/34/EU of the European Parliament and of the Council as regards the adjustments of the size criteria for micro, small, medium-sized and large undertakings or groups.</p>	<p><b>17/10/2024</b></p> <p><b><u>Unit:</u></b> <b><i>Company Law – Audit &amp; Accounting, Policy &amp; Legislation Unit.</i></b></p>	<p>Assessment has begun on the transposition requirements.</p> <p>The Commission will observe a two-month period of scrutiny for the Parliament and Council and once concluded will publish the delegated directive in the official journal.</p> <p>Member States will have 12 months from the date of entry into force to transpose the requirements into national legislation.</p>
